Overview

Performance presentations include music, dance, theatre, and creative writing.

Performance Presentation Guidelines

Music

Students may submit an abstract to perform an original composition, arrangement, or musical performance. Musical performances may be up to 10 minutes in length. Please prepare an additional five minutes for questions.

Dance

Students may submit an abstract for a dance performance or choreography piece. Dance performances may be up to 10 minutes in length. Please prepare an additional five minutes for questions.

Theatre

Students may submit abstracts to perform either an original or interpretive monologue or scene, consisting of up to 5 actors. Performances may be up to 10 minutes in length. Please prepare an additional five minutes for questions.

Creative Writing

Students may submit abstracts to present their poetry, fiction, prose, or hybrid work. Readings may be up to 15 minutes in length, if your work is longer, you will not be able to read it.

Original Film/Documentary

Students may submit abstracts to present their original films or documentaries. Film and documentary presentations may be up to 15 minutes in length. Please prepare an additional five minutes for questions. At the time of the scheduled performing arts session, students must be present to discuss their creative research process and answer questions.
