



### **Antwan T. Brooks, Sr. MBA RRT**

Antwan T. Brooks, Sr. MBA RRT is the Director of Respiratory Care and Neurodiagnostics at Capital Regional Medical Center. In this position, Antwan operates five departments: Respiratory Care, Electrocardiogram, Electroencephalogram, Echocardiography, and the Vascular Access Service Team.

By trade, Antwan is a Registered Respiratory Therapist, having graduated from the Respiratory Care Program at TCC in 2011. Following graduation Antwan started his career as a critical care respiratory therapist at TMH, and later began working at CRMC as well. He also worked at TCC as an adjunct instructor, teaching alongside the instructors that taught him. In 2013 Antwan earned his Bachelor's Degree in Respiratory Care from Boise State University. Three years later, while working as the Program Coordinator for the Pulmonary Rehabilitation center at TMH,

Antwan earned his Master's Degree in Business Administration at Boise State University. In 2017 Antwan began his current position at CRMC.

Outside of his work at CRMC, Antwan serves as the current Advisory Board Chair for the School of Cardiopulmonary Science at Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University. He is also the previous regional director for the Florida Society of Respiratory Care, an organization dedicated to political advocacy and opportunity development for respiratory therapists. Antwan is a part of Leadership Tallahassee (Class 37) as well as a member of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity Incorporated.

Antwan is married to Ashari Brooks and they have four children. In 2019, Antwan and Ashari started the Brooks Family Respiratory Care Scholarship at Tallahassee Community College in an effort to give back to the institution they both attended.
