Item Description

Disposition of Property per TCC Policy 6Hx27:09-10.

Overview and Background

The following vehicles were utilized exclusively by the Florida Public Safety Institute (FPSI) Driving Department and have outlived their useful life.

1988 Chevrolet Caprice	VIN: 1GBL5167JR191079	(TCC Property # 7207)
1989 Dodge Van	VIN: 2B4FK25KR337066	(TCC Property # 0140)
1985 Chevrolet Caprice	VIN: 1G1BL5169JR191083	(TCC Property # 7202)

Extensive aggressive driving for the purpose of driver education has contributed to extensive wear and tear, significantly diminishing the life of the vehicles. The current mileage for these vehicles is in excess of 100,000. In addition to standard maintenance and servicing, these vehicles have experienced a number of mechanical failures.

Section 274.05, FS, allows a governmental unit the discretion to classify as surplus any property that is obsolete, or the continued use of which is uneconomical or inefficient, or which serves no useful function. Section 274.06, FS, allows property which a governmental unit estimates to be under \$5,000, to be disposed of in the most efficient and cost effective means as determined by the governmental unit including disposal for value to any person, or disposal without bids to the state, or disposal to any governmental unit or to any political subdivision.

The three (3) Chevrolet Caprice cars were purchased by Region XV trust fund dollars. FPSI received approval to dispose of the vehicles from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) on July 30, 2012.
