Status: All findings, including repeat findings, from the SREF inspections report of November 2nd have been satisfied and concluded, with the exception of one finding that is being monitored. The report identified a crack in the FPAC building that facilities was already aware of and has been monitoring in order to determine the necessary actions required to completely correct the crack and prevent its return.
