

Enrollment Report - Fall 2023

Board Workshop Takeaways

- Fall 2023 credit enrollment at Tallahassee Community College has significantly increased – headcount is up 4.5% and credit hours are up 7.8% over fall 2022 with more students than ever taking full-time course loads (60%).
- Credit-seeking students from outside of the service district increased by 2%, up to 59% of the total student body, as did out-of-state/out-of-country, from 9% last fall to 11% this fall.
- This past spring, TCC established a new Office of Transfer Services and rebranded and refreshed our transfer program with FSU to Aspire with four pathways – Traditional, Elite, Honors and Online. As a result, enrollment in the program has increased 110%.
- TCC has been able to expand access to higher education both into the upper levels and the secondary level. We now have 184 students enrolled in our four bachelor's degrees, while dual enrollment has increased 19%.
