**SUBJECT:** Vision Statement

In Fall 2007, the Institutional Planning and Effectiveness Committee reviewed the Tallahassee Community College Mission and Vision statements as part of a five-year review process.

The Committee concluded that the current mission statement is more a reflection of what we are today than of what we want to become. The Committee offers the following Vision statement that centers on the concept of Tallahassee Community College being the community's foundational support, or keystone, for educational opportunities and solutions.

**Current Vision Statement**

Transforming lives and communities by providing access to affordable, high quality instruction in a supportive environment that embraces the diverse needs of its students.

**Proposed Vision Statement**

Tallahassee Community College will serve as the educational keystone for our diverse community by transforming lives through academic excellence, student success, service, and leadership.
